Consolidation Spring Term 2

What are the causes and effects of climate change?

We will examine some of the issues faced in urban areas and compare Rio in Brazil with Birmingham in the UK.

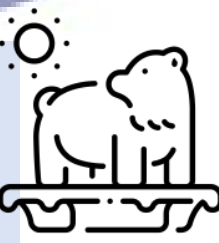
Revision Topics Spring Term 1
